How to use your simplyBus Smartcard



So, what is a simplyBus Smartcard?

A simplyBus Smartcard is a simple way to travel. It's an electronic card that can be used for:

- Tickets
- Money – your e-purse

You can pay for your ticket or add money to your simplyBus Smartcard using cash, or debit/credit card.



e-purse

You can use your simplyBus Smartcard as an e-purse. By adding money to your card you don't have to carry cash for your bus journey. You never have to find the right change, as the fare you choose is taken off the card by the bus driver.

How do I get a simplyBus Smartcard?

Fill out the online form, pay with your debit or credit card and your new simplyBus Smartcard will be sent to you by post.
