Thames Valley Park

Thames Valley Park is one of Europe's leading business developments occupying a site of 200 acres with a mile long River Thames frontage. Originally the site of the Earley Power Station it is now home to some of the world's biggest corporate players.

A master plan was conceived to integrate high quality office accommodation within a parkland setting. The first offices, completed in 1991 were sold to BG Group. Oracle Corporation acquired the remaining land in 1994 and began construction to include a nursery and leisure club. Part of the site was sold to Microsoft for their headquarter building and part to Argent Real Estates who developed five buildings. Oracle Corporation completed their own headquarters buildings on the part they retained.

Thames Valley Park Management Ltd. was formed by the owners in 1998 to manage the common areas, including the 100 acre nature reserve. The reserve is a haven for wildlife and homes several rare species of bird, mammal, plant and insect. It has been quoted as being "a shining example of sustainable development."

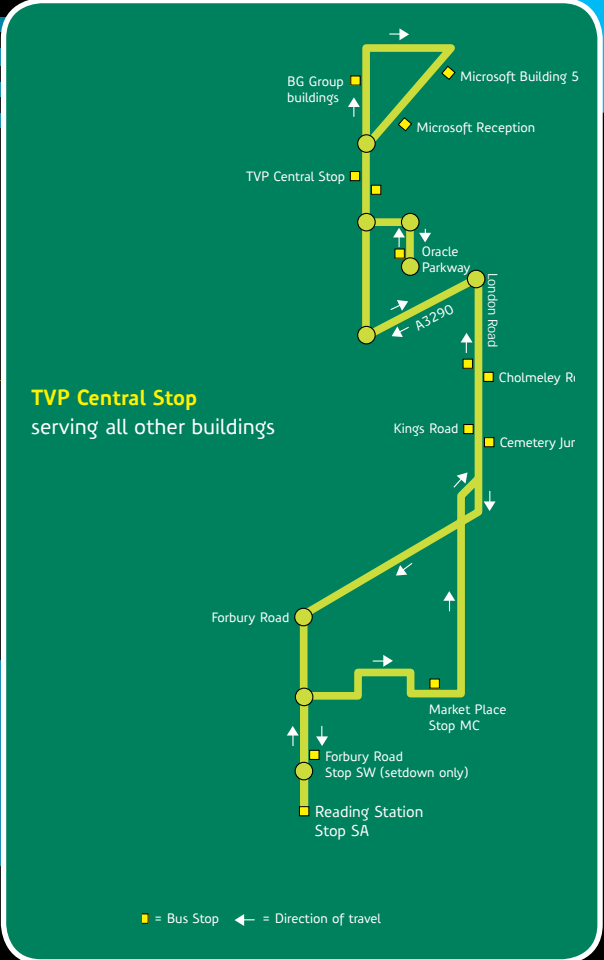

- ### How to use the service
- For journeys to Reading you can only board at stops within TVP.
 - For journeys from Reading you can only leave the bus at stops within TVP.
 - To board the bus raise your arm requesting the driver to stop.
 - To leave the bus ring the bell in good time to request the driver to stop.
 - Subject to traffic conditions in the town centre, buses may take alternative routes to the railway station.
 - Oracle Parkway stop is served in both directions
 - Your driver will announce any necessary changes to the timetable.
