

1. The Reading Buses Jobseekers ID card, (herein after referred to as "The ID card) remains the property of Reading Transport and must be surrendered on demand.
2. The ID card is used to obtain bus travel at a reduced adult rate as determined at the time by Reading Buses. This will usually be the same price as child rate, however Reading Buses reserves the right to change this at any time.
3. Each ID card is issued with a valid to date. The card is invalid outside of this date and a new one must be obtained.
4. Customers using an ID card are subject to P.C.V. regulations and Reading Buses standard conditions relating to the carriage of customers.
5. The ID card is not transferable and must only be used by the person for whom it is issued, if transferred it will be forfeited and the user and the person who transferred it will be liable to prosecution.
6. Customers with an ID card do not have priority over other customers.
7. Reading Buses reserves the right to amend, without notice, availability of ID card in the event of changes to its services.
8. The ID card must be produced for inspection when required by any authorised employee of Reading Buses. If it cannot be produced, the fare for the journey must be paid in full without right of refund.
9. The ID card is liable to forfeit if damaged, defaced, misused or out of date.
10. Any loss of an ID card should be reported immediately to Reading Buses and a payment of £2.00 will be charged for a replacement.
11. No refunds will be made in respect of lost or forfeit of an ID card. The period of validity will not be extended in any circumstances.
12. Your ID card can only be used in the 'simplyReading' area.
13. Replacement of ID cards and refunds in respect of unused Travel cards will be at the discretion of Reading Buses.
14. Reading Buses reserves the right to refuse to renew an ID card.
15. ID cards will not be issued more than 3 days in advance of the required starting date.
16. Customers can only use their ID card on day services and up to 4am on purple 17. This ID is not valid on any NightTrack service.
17. Any change of address must be notified to Reading Buses in writing.
18. Completion and signature of the application form will be held to as acceptance of these conditions and any breach of them will render the ID card liable to forfeit and the user liable to prosecution.
19. I agree to accept the Jobseekers ID card subject to the conditions, plus the conditions that apply to all users of Reading and Newbury Buses. I declare that at the time of application I am unemployed and seeking a job. If I am successful in finding a job during the period of validity of the ID card, I will return the ID card immediately to Reading Buses.
